## Guide to Registering for People who are Seeking Asylum<sup>2</sup>

There are 2 papers to fill in this registration pack.

We also need copies of documents with your name, date of birth and address.<sup>3</sup>

### 1. Fill in the GMS1 Form

= Very important information

- Patient's details:** Includes fields for Mr/Ms/Ms/Ms, Surname, Date of birth, First names, Previous surnames, NHS No., Sex (Male/Female), Town and country of birth, Home address, Postcode, and Telephone number.

- If you are from abroad:** A field for the first UK address where registered with a GP.
- Previously resident in UK:** A field for the date you first came to live in UK.
- If you are returning from the Armed Forces:** A field for the address before enlisting.
- Service or Personnel number:** A field for the service or personnel number.
- Enlistment date:** A field for the enlistment date.
- If you are registering a child under 5:** A checkbox for "I wish the child above to be registered with the doctor named overleaf for Child Health Surveillance".
- If you need your doctor to dispense medicines and appliances\*:** Three checkboxes: "I live more than 1 mile in a straight line from the nearest chemist", "I would have serious difficulty in getting them from a chemist", and "We all doctors are authorised to dispense medicines".
- Signature and Date:** Fields for the patient's signature (or on behalf of patient) and the date.



<sup>2</sup> We cannot register you if we do not have sufficient or clear information. If we receive an application and cannot process it we will telephone you with an interpreter to see if we can go forward with the application. If we cannot contact you by phone or we cannot resolve the information issue we will write to you to return the application. If you require urgent medical attention we will discuss a way forward with you.

<sup>3</sup> We can register people without documents but it really helps us if we have documents with correct names, dates of birth and addresses. We must be very careful that we do not create NHS records using incorrect information.

- You are NOT allowed to work or engage in any business unless you have been explicitly granted permission to do so.


Failure to comply with any of the above restrictions, without reasonable excuse, is a criminal offence.<sup>3</sup>

ANY CHANGE OF RESTRICTION

If these restrictions are to be changed, we will write to you.

- Although you have been temporarily admitted, you remain liable to be detained.
- This document Does Not confer a right to work and must not be accepted as such.
- You have NOT been given leave to enter the United Kingdom within the meaning of the Immigration Act 1971.
